The Arche Health Wangen Murduin Integrated Team Care (ITC) Program aims to improve the health of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people living with a chronic condition(s).

The program strives to improve access to high quality, culturally appropriate health care services.

We are able to help Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander clients access the care they need that is outlined in their GP Management Plan (GPMP) by their GP.



Eligibility

- Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander
- Ongoing chronic condition that has lasted for more than six months
- Have ITC referral form completed by your GP
- Have a current GP Management Plan (GPMP)

Supplementary Services relevant to your condition Include

This service can provide support for:

- GAP fees for Medical specialist visits
- GAP fees for Allied health visits
- Transport assistance to GP and medical specialist appointments
- Monitoring equipment ie blood pressure monitor
- Mobility Aids
- Spectacles
- Medical Footwear
- Webster packaging
- Assistive breathing items (eg CPAP)
